Vigilant	alert or watchful for possible signs of danger.
Leak	a liquid or gas escaping in or out through a hole.
Ventilate	to allow fresh air to circular through a room.
Scolded	spoke angrily.
Accumulated	gathered or collected.
Regulator	a device to control the pressure of gas or liquid.
Evacuate	to move from a place of danger to a safe place.
Technicians	people who are trained or skilled to do a particular work.
