1. The seven continents are Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe and Australia. The Pacific Ocean, the Atlantic Ocean, the Indian Ocean, the Southern Ocean and the Arctic Ocean are the five major oceans of the world.
2. The plants and animals that live inside an ocean or sea are known as marine life.
3. During summer, the ice melts to form large icebergs and floating islands called 'ice floes', in the Arctic Ocean.
4. Mid-Atlantic Ridge is a long range of undersea mountains that lie beneath the Atlantic Ocean.
5. Asia is the largest continent of the seven continents. Some of the world's largest and most populated countries such as China and India are located in Asia. Asia has varied and interesting geographical features. Asia also has the highest mountain ranges in the world such as Himalayas and Karakoram ranges. The world's highest peak Mt Everest is located in Asia. It is
